“Marlothii is a place of love and caring.”

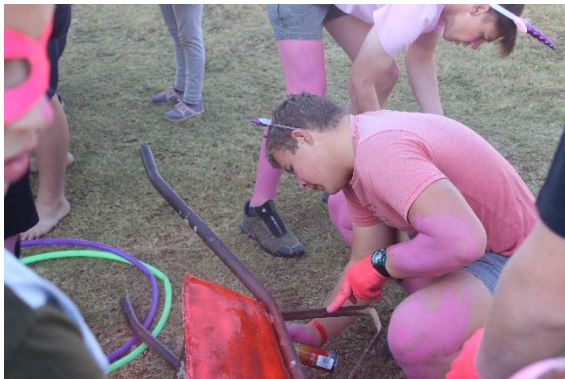
“It’s a home away from home.”
